**Title: Hurricane Sandy Exposures and Health Effects in WTC Responders**

**Dr. Gonzalez will speak about the work being done at the Stony Brook World Trade Center (WTC) Health Program to examine the health effects of Hurricane Sandy in responders to the WTC disaster. He will report on Sandy exposures and their associations with changes in health outcomes pre-to-post Sandy. He will also discuss a new resiliency training program being evaluated in disaster responders.**
